Dear Friends,

It is our great joy to tell you that the Committee on Ministry of New Harmony Presbytery has approved the work and reports of our Mission Assessment Team! We are thankful to God for the service of this hard-working group. Avery Dickson and Cathy Chapman served as co-chairs. Other Team members were Christie McLeod, Kim Brabham, Robby Bennett and Calvin Phillips.

Now our congregation is going forward in the second part of our search for our next installed pastor. This began with the election of the Pastor Nominating Committee, or "search committee," on February 26. We elected a total of 6 people – three who had served on the Mission Assessment Team (Cathy Chapman, Christie McLeod and Calvin Phillips), and three more to work with them (John Long, Kristin Miller and Katelyn Evans). It was strongly recommended that 2-3 persons from the Mission Assessment Team also serve on the Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC), and we are doing that.

The PNC will begin its meetings very soon. As your interim minister, I will join with them as an advisory member for the first part of their work. They will prepare what is called a Mission Information Form, our Church's resume. Then, when that is approved, they will actually receive prospective pastor's resumes and do actual interviews. Everyone of us is asked to lift up our PNC in our daily prayers. Pray for God's clear guidance, energy, insights, teamwork and wisdom. Encourage the PNC members when you see them. Their work is confidential. We can be sure that they will be very busy on our Church's behalf. So, we cannot ask them individually for updates, but we can offer them encouraging words and our prayers.

In the meantime, our Church's missions and ministries continue to grow. Our new Music Director, Mrs. Mary Louise Baker, works weekly with our children and adult choirs. Our Fellowship Team has planned several all-church gatherings for this spring (see more details later in this newsletter). Our Christian Education Team gives leadership to our Sunday School and Youth programs. Our Administration team has completed the 2023 budget, just approved by the session. Plus, they are upgrading their list of projects for our buildings and grounds for this year and next. Our Membership Team welcomes our newest members. And that is only a partial list!

This is a great time to be an active member of First Presbyterian Church! Invite other people to join us for our worship, mission and fellowship times. Share the good news of Jesus Christ in your loving kindness to one another, and neighbors all around you.



Parlor Class Lenten Study <u>Seven Words</u> by Susan Robb Feb 12th-March 19th

The most difficult part of Lent is, of course, contemplating our Savior on the cross: the physical pain, the humiliation, and the undeniable injustice. Our hearts break. It's natural to try and avoid the reality of how Jesus died, but it is from the cross that Jesus shows his deepest love for us. As Jesus draws his final breath and utters his last words, it is then that his deep trust in the Father and his divine glory are revealed. This study looks at Christ's final words from a biblical and historical perspective, showing how we can find life and hope in them.

Parlor Class Spring Series Words of Life by Adam Hamilton March 26th- May 28th

In this book of Scripture and inspiration, bestselling author Adam Hamilton brings modern eyes to the most important set of ethics in history. He considers the commandments in their historical context,

considering the meaning of each commandment in Hebrew, unpacking how Jesus reinterpreted them, and showing how every thou-shalt-not was intended to point to a life-giving "thou shalt." He also explores how the latest research in science and psychology illuminates these commandments, rightly understood, as a way of ordering one's life beautifully in the present day.
