Dear Friends,

What an amazing and fast 13 months we have had together, as I served as your interim pastor! October 1 will be my last workday as your interim, but I will also preach and lead worship on the Sundays of October 8 and 15. When I think back on my year with you, many pictures come to mind. I think of my first Sunday back with you last September, when my sermon title was, "What If We Told the Truth?" And we did speak truth to each other as we went through a discernment process that led to a pastor search committee that led to our next pastor being called (our September 24 congregational vote was unanimous). I hope to be a guest in worship from time to time, and perhaps even a summer vacation supply preacher. I will keep you in my prayers as, hopefully, you will continue to remember our family. I will always thank God for you, and our thirteen months together.

Mission Outreach Ministry will have a church grounds clean-up day Saturday, October 28 from 8:00 until 12:00. Bring rakes, chainsaws, shovels, hedge trimmers and gloves. Our main focus will be on cleaning up the backyard of the Fellowship Building and manse yard.

The church sanctuary now has a hearing loop installed. This is a system that sends the audio captured on the microphones directly into a hearing aid worn by anyone in the congregation. The system provides the cleanest, clearest sound imaginable for hearing aid wearers and does not require a headset, as it works with any hearing aid that has a T-coil. We also have a limited supply of loop receivers and headsets that can be used during worship if your hearing aid is not equipped with a t-coil. For assistance during worship, feel free to ask an usher.

If you wear a hearing aid and are unsure if it is equipped with a T-coil, please consult with your audiologist.
